SCHOLARSHIP #2 - LEADERSHIP

This award, which is designed to encompass the applicant's personal experience, will give young women the opportunity to write about their own opinions regarding the community in which they live. In addition to developing skills for written expression, participants will also have the opportunity to win a \$500 scholarship! This award is based on the applicant's leadership potential as expressed in an essay answering the following question:

Due to the recent outbreak of Covid-19 in Newfoundland and Labrador, in-class instruction has been suspended for all K-12 students across the province.

What are the benefits of learning in an online classroom environment and what advice can you give your fellow NL students as they navigate learning in a virtual world?

Include examples from your own experience as a student currently attending class through online platforms like Google Classroom/Google Meet.

Essay length should be between 500-1000 words, and **MUST** be received by **Midnight on March 31, 2021**.

SCHOLARSHIP # 3 - COMMUNICATIONS

An important attribute and quality of a leader is the ability to demonstrate composure, confidence and intelligence when speaking in public. Speeches should be no longer than **two minutes**. The use of notes is permitted, however should not be relied on. Participants will be assessed on their ability to demonstrate empathy and a realistic understanding of their chosen topic. What are you passionate about? Tell us about it.

MANL will award \$500 to the applicant selected by our panel of Public Speaking /Communications Award judges. The winner will also receive a \$2,000 tuition voucher from Dale Carnegie Training.

Speeches **MUST** be recorded as a video and emailed in **MP4 format**, or provided as a **You Tube link with private settings**. The file name **MUST** include your name and community. Videos **MUST** be emailed along with the scholarship application (**Tell Us About Yourself**) section to: **contact@missachievement.com** by **Midnight on March 31, 2021**.
